**BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2018-280**  
September 20, 2018

**WHEREAS**, a Purchase Request (PR #18-04-391) for the *Supply and Delivery of MMDA Uniforms Lot 2: Supply and Delivery of Uniforms for GASD, HPSEPO, Public Safety, Anti Littering, Anti Smoking, MSSO, MPCG, Metro Aides, Foreman, Supervisor, ASBU, TEC, TED, SWMO, and SCOG*, with an Approved Budget for the Contract of Three Million, Ninety-Two Thousand Pesos (Php3,092,000.00) was duly approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE);

**WHEREAS**, on May 21, 2018, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) advertised the Invitation to Bid at MMDA website, PhilGEPS and a conspicuous place at the premises of the MMDA continuously for 7 days;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisement, three (3) prospective bidders purchased bid documents and submitted their bid on June 18, 2018 which was rated passed during the preliminary examination. Hereunder shown, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, upon recomputation and evaluation of the bid amounts of the remaining bidders on July 10, 2018, the same yielded the following results:

**WHEREAS**, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the lowest calculated bid (WOMAN FINE CLOTHING, INC.) has been found to be non-responsive. The Statement of all Ongoing Projects and Contracts failed to indicate the correct value of outstanding works. As reflected from said document, projects delivered were still included as part of its outstanding works. NFCC computation is erroneous. Said document does not reflect the correct Net Financial Contracting Capacity due to wrong value of outstanding contracts as a result to the finding on item one (1) of the submitted document.



**WHEREAS**, having given notification to the concerned bidder of their non-compliance, the BAC rules that such non-compliance is fatal and therefore renders WOMAN FINE CLOTHING, INC. ineligible and disqualified and proceeded to post qualify the second lowest calculated bidder, LA MARINA ENTERPRISES, INC.

**WHEREAS**, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the second lowest calculated bid (LA MARINA ENTERPRISES, INC.) has been found to be non-responsive. There is no Tax Clearance Certificate attached. Issuance date and expiry date of Tax reflected in the Certificate of Philgeps Registration have the same date which is June 2, 2018 and is expired at the time of bid opening on June 18, 2018, In addition, said bidder filed Request for Certification on Outstanding Tax Liability/ies of Taxpayer to Bureau of Internal Revenue, Revenue Region No. 8, Revenue District Office No. 049. Consequently, BIR issued Delinquency Verification Report for Tax Clearance and Certification on Outstanding Tax Liability/ies of Taxpayers stating La Marina Enterprises, Inc. has eighteen (18) open cases;

**WHEREAS**, For purposes of complying with the eligibility requirements, the Tax Clearance and all other eligibility documents, must be valid and existing at the time it is submitted to the BAC, that is, on or before the deadline for the submission of bids. Thus, an expired Tax Clearance shown in Annex A of the PhilGEPS Platinum Certificate shall not be considered as sufficient compliance, without the new valid Tax Clearance attached in the bid submitted by the bidder. The belated submission of the Tax Clearance during the post-qualification shall be considered a modification or improvement of the bid, which is not allowed under Section 26 of the Revised IRR (GPPB NPM No. 065-1017).

**WHEREAS**, having given notification to the concerned bidder of their non-compliance, the BAC rules that such non-compliance is fatal and therefore renders LA MARINA ENTERPRISES, INC. ineligible and disqualified and proceeded to post qualify the third and last bidder, DELS APPAREL CORPORATION.


**WHEREAS**, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, DELS APPAREL CORPORATION has been found to be responsive;

**NOW THEREFORE**, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To declare DELS APPAREL CORPORATION, as the Bidder with the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid for the Supply and Delivery of MMDA Uniform, Lot 2: Supply and Delivery of Uniforms for GASD, HPSEPO, Public Safety, Anti-Littering, Anti-Smoking, MSSO, MPCG, Metro Aides, Foreman, Supervisions, ASBU, TEC, TED, SWMO, and SCOG;
- b) To recommend to the Chairman the award of contract to **DELS APPAREL CORPORATION**, at the amount of Three Million, Ninety-Two Thousand Pesos (**Php 3,092,000.00**).
