REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Feasibility Study for the Safe Closure and Rehabilitation Plan of Carmona Sanitary Landfill

1. The *Metropolitan Manila Development Authority*, through the *General Appropriations Act (RA 10964)* intends to apply the sum of *Ten Million Four Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Pesos (Php 10,422,000.00)* being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for *Feasibility Study for the Safe Closure and Rehabilitation Plan of Carmona Sanitary Landfill*. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The *Metropolitan Manila Development Authority* now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for *Feasibility Study for the Safe Closure and Rehabilitation Plan of Carmona Sanitary Landfill*. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before *June 7, 2018, 5:00PM* at Ground Floor, Institute of Traffic Management Building, R. Magsaysay cor. Orense St. Guadalupe, Makati City. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from *Metropolitan Manila Development Authority* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during *8:00AM – 5:00PM*.
4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on *May 31, 2018* from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of *Php 25,000.00*

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.



5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of *three (3) – five (5)* prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:
 - a) *Consulting Firm- 20% (Experience in Environmental Consultancy, Ongoing and Completed Projects)*
 - b) *Team Leader - 15% (Education, Professional Experience, Design, Construction, and Supervision Experience, No. of SWM Projects)*
 - c) *Team Composition - 65% (Environmental Specialist, Hydrologist, Hydrogeologist/Geologist, Civil Engineer, Geodetic Engineer, Economist/Financial Analyst, Architect/Urban Planner, Public Health Specialist, Support Staff)*

6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

7. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS)* procedure. The Procuring Entity shall indicate the weights to be allocated for the Technical and Financial Proposals/. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.
8. The contract shall be completed within *six (6) months*.
9. The *Metropolitan Manila Development Authority* reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.




