BAC RESOLUTION NO. 2018-451

WHEREAS, Purchase Request (PR) No. 18-05-494 dated April 19, 2018 for the **Supply and Delivery of 251 Pairs Safety Shoes, 285 Pairs Rubber Boots, 780 pcs. Raincoats, etc. for Various Pumping Stations** with an approved budget for the contract of **One Million Six Hundred Forty Five Thousand Six Hundred & 32/100 (Php1,645,600.32)**, was duly approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity (HOPE);

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer certified the existence of funds for this procurement;

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2018, the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) advertised the Invitation to Bid at MMDA website, PhilGEPS and a conspicuous place at the premises of the MMDA continuously for 7 days;

WHEREAS, Bid Bulletin No. 1 dated July 9, 2018 was issued that rain boots should be supplied with various sizes for the abovementioned project;

WHEREAS, Bid Bulletin No. 2 dated July 9, 2018 was issued that the project title stated in the Invitation to Bid, Item Nos. 1 and 2 should be **Supply and Delivery of 251 Pairs Safety Shoes, 285 Pairs Rubber Boots, 780 pcs. Raincoats, etc. for Various Pumping Stations**;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, four (4) prospective bidders purchased bid documents and submitted its bid on July 16, 2018 which were rated passed during the preliminary examination. Hereunder shown, as follows:

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the Lowest Calculated Bidder, **KRYPTON INTERNATIONAL RESOURCES SALES AND SERVICES, INC.**, has been found not to comply with, and be responsive to,

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the following requirements and conditions as follows: (1) Misdeclaration of "List of all On-going Government and Private Contract including contracts awarded but not yet started". As reflected from said document, the value of outstanding works/undelivered portion does not represent the actual value based on the declared percentage (%) of accomplishment as computed. This resulted to an over declaration of the cost of on-going projects; (2) Misdeclaration of NFCC computation. Said document does not reflect the correct Net Financial Contracting Capacity due to wrong value of outstanding contracts as a result of the finding on item one (1); and (3) Incomplete Audited Financial Statements for the Year Ended December 31, 2017 due to absence of Balance Sheet and Income Statement.

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the Second Lowest Calculated Bidder, AGP TRADING INCORPORATED, has been found not to comply with, and be responsive to, the following requirements and conditions as follows: (1) Misdeclaration of "Statement of all Ongoing Projects and Contracts" has failed to indicate the correct value of outstanding works. As reflected from said document, projects delivered (based on attached supporting documents) were still included as part of its outstanding works. Further, said statement failed to indicate the respective percentage (%) of accomplishments for each project and (2) NFCC computation is erroneous. Said document does not reflect the correct Net Financial Contracting Capacity due to wrong value of outstanding contracts as a result of the finding on item one (1).

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the Third Lowest Calculated Bidder, DELS APPAREL CORPORATION, has been found not to comply with, and be responsive to, the following requirements and conditions as follows: (1) No attached Warranty Certificate as required under Special Conditions Contract (SCC) per Section 17.4 of the bidding documents; and (2) No attached copy of Product Certification on hard hat, as EN397 compliant, required under Technical Specifications.

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification or careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements submitted, the Fourth Lowest Calculated Bidder, KING'S SAFETYNET, INC., has been found to be responsive;

NOW THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED:

- a) To declare **KING'S SAFETYNET, INC.** as the Bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the **Supply and Delivery of 251 Pairs Safety Shoes, 285 Pairs Rubber Boots, 780 pcs. Raincoats, etc. for Various Pumping Stations;**
- b) To recommend to the Chairman the award of contract to **KING'S SAFETYNET, INC.** at the amount of **One Million Five Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (Php1,597,400.00).**
