

COMMITTEE ON AWARD
Resolution No. 15-098
May 4, 2015

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2015, the Bids and Awards Committee conducted a public bidding for the Supply & delivery of 26 Seater Ferry Boat;

WHEREAS, Invitation to Bid No. 001-2015-GOODS-FERRY was advertised in accordance with law;

WHEREAS, in response to the call for bids, thirteen (13) prospective bidders were able to log-in in the PhilGEPS, but only two (2) bidders, submitted their Letters of Intent and purchased the Bid Documents namely:

1. Stoneworks Specialist Int'l. Corp.
2. Manila Vikings Boat Sales Inc.

WHEREAS, at the time of the bidding, the above-mentioned bidders were in attendance and submitted their technical and financial proposal;

WHEREAS, the first envelope containing the technical component of the bid, including the eligibility requirements of the two bidders were opened and forwarded to the Technical Working Groups for evaluation;

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2015, the Technical Working Group submitted their evaluation report stating that after thorough evaluation of the technical specification of FRP required by the Pasig River Ferry System they are recommending to the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) the ferry boats being offered by Manila Vikings Boat Sales, Inc.;

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2015, the BAC issued Notice of Opening of Financial Proposal of Manila Vikings Boat Sales, Inc., who was found to be eligible to proceed to the said stage;

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2015, the BAC received a Motion for Reconsideration from Stoneworks Specialist stating that they have complied the required technical specifications and therefore, also eligible to proceed to the opening of the Financial Proposal;

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2015, the BAC answered all the issues raised by Stoneworks Specialist in their Motion for Reconsideration emphasizing that since their technical proposal, specifically the materials to be used did not pass the technical evaluation their company has been declared ineligible to proceed to the opening of the Financial Proposal;

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2015, the BAC received a Rejoinder to the Motion for Reconsideration of their ineligibility to proceed to the next stage;

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2015, the BAC through its letter to Stoneworks Specialist Inc. reiterated that their company is deemed ineligible to proceed to the next stage;

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2015, Stoneworks Specialist Inc. again reiterated that their technical proposal has passed the required technical specifications and requested for the opening of their Financial Proposal;

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2015, in the interest of transparency and competitiveness, the BAC has deemed that the financial envelope of the two (2) participating bidders be opened on April 29, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, the bid proposal of the two eligible bidders were forwarded to the End-user and Technical Working Group for post evaluation and comparison with the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) which is **P18,925,000.00**;

WHEREAS, the post qualification of the two eligible bidders were conducted to verify, ascertain and evaluate their eligibility, technical and financial proposals;

WHEREAS, as evaluated using the aforementioned criteria, Manila Vikings Boat Sales Inc. passed all of the criteria and was post qualified at the lowest calculated responsive bid of P18,475,000.00 (see Bid Evaluation Report dated May 4, 2015);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, the undersigned members of the Committee hereby recommends to award the contract for the above-mentioned requirements to Manila Vikings Boat Sales Inc.
