IMPLEMENTING THE USE OF FACE SHIELDS DURING THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION PURSUANT TO THE OMNIBUS GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE PHILIPPINES AS AMENDED ON 16 JULY 2020 AND OTHER RELATED ISSUANCES

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF MEID) issued the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines as amended on 16 July 2020 therein prescribing minimum public health standards at all times for the duration of the General Community Quarantine, *e. g.*, use of face shields, among others;

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), and Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) issued their respective Circulars on the use of face shields in all modes of public transportation, in workplaces, and in all private establishments regardless of economic activity (Ref: DOTr Memorandum Circular No. 2020-014 and DOLE & DTI Joint Memorandum Circular No. 20-04);

WHEREAS, on 31 August 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared that the National Capital Region shall remain under General Community Quarantine from 01 September 2020 until 30 September 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council, through the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority and the seventeen (17) Metro Manila Local Government Units and its Local Chief Executives, shall implement the use of face shields during the General Community Quarantine in the National Capital Region pursuant to the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines as amended on 16 July 2020 and other related issuances, thus:

1. The face shields must be worn by all persons while using any mode of public transportation, in the workplace, indoors, and in all crowded public or private places such as, but not limited to, markets, groceries, stores, banks, money transfer centers, and transportation terminals, *except* that the face shields may be removed according to the demands of the work or when the occupational safety and health of the employees so require and subject to the existing Ordinances, Executive Orders, and other issuances of the seventeen (17) Metro Manila Local Government Units.

2. The face shields must completely cover the sides and length of the face as prescribed by the World Health Organization *provided* that "visor-type" face shields shall not be allowed, and *provided further* that the face shields shall be worn together with face masks.






