**MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 21-04**  
**Series of 2021**

**SETTING THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) TO SIXTY-FIVE (65) YEARS OLD FOR AUTHORIZED PERSONS OUTSIDE OF RESIDENCE IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION STARTING 16 MARCH 2021 UNTIL 31 MARCH 2021 THROUGH THE METRO MANILA LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS**

**WHEREAS**, recent COVID-19 data shows that beginning March 2021, in comparison with February 2021, the National Capital Region (NCR) continues to have a relatively high number of daily new infections;

**WHEREAS**, at present, the age of authorized persons outside of residence (APOR) is fifteen (15) to sixty-five (65) years old in the NCR;


**WHEREAS**, however, based on the data of the Department of Health, there has been a marked increase in the active COVID-19 cases among persons below the age of eighteen (18) years old and thus, the imperative to regulate the movement of such age group in order to prevent a further rise in such cases;


**WHEREAS**, the seventeen (17) Local Chief Executives in Metro Manila agreed to enact or amend their respective Executive Orders and/or adopt their respective Ordinances setting the age of eighteen (18) to sixty-five (65) years old for APOR in the NCR starting 16 March 2021 until 31 March 2021, *provided, however*, that exemptions may be granted therefrom for medical and health care, food and vital services, work-related activities, and other essential travel as may be determined by the issuing authority;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council sets the age of **eighteen (18) to sixty-five (65) years old for authorized persons outside of residence (APOR) in the National Capital Region starting 16 March 2021 until 31 March 2021 through the Metro Manila Local Government Units.**


This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.






