URGING THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES TO CONSIDER THE EASING OF COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR FULLY-VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11525 (COVID-19 Vaccination Program Act of 2021) seeks to address the adverse impact of COVID-19 through the procurement and administration of safe and effective vaccines by the National Government through the Department of Health, the National Task Force Against COVID-19, and other duly constituted authorities and instrumentalities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Philippine National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 Vaccines, some Local Government Units (LGUs) in the National Capital Region (NCR) have reached or are nearing their vaccination targets after inoculating the residents and workers within their respective territorial jurisdictions who belong to the A1 to A4 Categories;


WHEREAS, while the LGUs in the NCR are mindful of the health and public safety concerns which are occasioned by the pandemic, they are equally aware that the economic activity in the NCR must be bolstered by allowing fully-vaccinated individuals to engage in businesses and other activities which are otherwise prohibited or restricted under the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases;


WHEREAS, the easing of the aforesaid Guidelines in favor of fully-vaccinated individuals would not only boost employment, industry, services, and other economic endeavors but would likewise encourage the rest of the population to have themselves vaccinated with the end of achieving herd immunity at the soonest possible time;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved that, the Metro Manila Council urges the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to consider the easing of the COVID-19 Guidelines for fully-vaccinated individuals in the National Capital Region subject to the conduct of an inter-agency and inter-disciplinary study to determine the appropriate policy therefor based on scientific and empirical evidence.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.
