**EXPRESSING THE READINESS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS
OF METRO MANILA TO VACCINATE NON-RESIDENTS IN THE
NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION IN SUPPORT OF THE “WE VAX AS ONE”
VACCINATION POLICY IN ORDER TO ATTAIN POPULATION
PROTECTION**

WHEREAS, the Philippine National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 Vaccines is guided by the principles of Shared Responsibility and Integration, among others, wherein Shared Responsibility calls for a “Whole-Of-Society-Approach” and enjoins all members of the society to assume their vital and collective roles in the COVID-19 vaccine deployment and vaccination program while Integration declares that the vaccination of Filipino citizens against COVID-19 is an integral part of the government’s pandemic response;

WHEREAS, there are some Local Government Units (LGUs) in the National Capital Region (NCR) which have reached or are nearing their vaccination targets after inoculating the residents and workers within their respective territorial jurisdictions who belong to the A1 to A4 Categories;

WHEREAS, on the other hand, there are some LGUs in the NCR as well as LGUs in neighboring regions which are presently confronted with challenges in meeting their vaccination targets in the A1 to A4 Categories owing to their large population, lack of manpower and supplies, or some other cogent reasons;

WHEREAS, given the porous borders of the NCR, there is a need for non-NCR residents, together with their families, to be vaccinated in order to contain, suppress, and reduce the spread of COVID-19 in the Region;

WHEREAS, as a concrete demonstration of the “One Voice, One Vote” principle, the LGUs in the NCR wholly advocate the “We Vax As One” vaccination policy in order to further increase their inoculation performance with a view of attaining population protection at the earliest possible time;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved that, the Metro Manila Council expresses the readiness of the Local Government Units of Metro Manila to vaccinate non-residents in the National Capital Region in support of the “We Vax As One” vaccination policy and inoculate qualified vaccinees from areas which are outside of their territorial jurisdictions based on the following policies:

1. The Local Government Units of Metro Manila shall undertake the above-mentioned inoculation based on their respective assessment and capacity taking into consideration their vaccination targets, available manpower, vaccination sites, and other logistical requirements for the purpose. The Local Government Units of Metro Manila shall prioritize those who are residents in the National Capital Region before inoculating persons who are from other territorial jurisdictions.

2. The vaccination shall be strictly by appointment only utilizing online applications/platforms or other pre-registration procedures which may be adopted or developed by the concerned Local Government Unit. Walk-in vaccinees shall not be accommodated.

3. The Local Government Units of Metro Manila, consistent with their relevant Ordinances as well as pertinent national laws and issuances, shall adopt and implement procedures and require relevant documentation from said vaccinees. Particularly, in order to safeguard against the unauthorized inoculation of persons utilizing government-procured vaccines per the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) issued by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for COVID-19 vaccines, prior to inoculation, all vaccinees shall:


- (a) be required to present their government-issued proof of identification; and
- (b) execute a written declaration that the jab which they seek to receive is not an additional or booster shot.


Any form of misrepresentation or falsification on the part of the vaccinees shall be prosecuted under applicable laws.

4. The inoculation undertaken by the Local Government Units of Metro Manila shall be recorded as part of their vaccination performance and reported as such to the Department of Information and Communications Technology and the Department of Health.

This Resolution shall be effective immediately after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.
