MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 21-21

**SETTING THE STANDARDIZED AND UNIFIED CURFEW HOURS
FROM 10:00 P.M. TO 4:00 A.M. STARTING ON 16 SEPTEMBER 2021
THROUGH THE METRO MANILA LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS
ON ACCOUNT OF THE COVID-19 ALERT LEVEL 4 IN THE
NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION**

WHEREAS, on 13 September 2021, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases has approved the “Guidelines on the Pilot Implementation of Alert Levels System for COVID-19 Response in the National Capital Region”;

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region will be placed under the COVID-19 Alert Level 4 starting on 16 September 2021 until 30 September 2021;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part I, Section 3 of the aforesaid Guidelines, areas placed under Alert Level 4 shall be under certain restrictions and protocols as stated therein;


WHEREAS, the Metro Manila Council recognizes the imperative to gradually but cautiously open the economy in order to increase business activity, reduce unemployment and underemployment, and promote economic growth, while at the same time equally being mindful of the paramount interests of public health and public safety;


WHEREAS, pursuant to the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines and the Guidelines aforementioned, all the Local Chief Executives in Metro Manila have agreed to enact their respective Executive Orders and/or adopt or amend their respective Ordinances for the proper implementation of the standardized and unified curfew hours;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council shall set the standardized and unified curfew hours in the National Capital Region **from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. starting on 16 September 2021 through the Metro Manila Local Government Units.**

This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.



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
