**MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 21-23**  
**Series of 2021**

**SETTING THE STANDARDIZED AND UNIFIED CURFEW HOURS  
FROM 12:00 MIDNIGHT TO 4:00 A.M. STARTING ON 13 OCTOBER  
2021 THROUGH THE METRO MANILA LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
UNITS**

**WHEREAS**, on 10 October 2021, the Department of Health (DOH) has reported that there is a general decrease in COVID-19 active cases in the National Capital Region on account of rapid and efficient detect and isolate strategies and enhanced vaccination efforts, among others. However, the DOH encouraged the continued observance and enforcement of COVID-19 protocols and minimum public health standards in order to avoid a future rise in active cases;

**WHEREAS**, the Metro Manila Council recognizes the imperative to gradually but cautiously open the economy in order to increase business activity, reduce unemployment and underemployment, and promote economic growth while at the same time equally being mindful of the paramount interests of public health and public safety;


**WHEREAS**, the curfew hours being presently implemented in the National Capital Region under Alert Level 4, *i.e.*, 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., has to be adjusted in light of the recent developments particularly the steady decrease of active cases in the Region;


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines and its amendments, all the Local Chief Executives in Metro Manila have agreed to enact their respective Executive Orders and/or adopt or amend their respective Ordinances for the proper implementation of the standardized and unified curfew hours;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council shall set the standardized and unified curfew hours in the National Capital Region **from 12:00 midnight to 4:00 a.m. starting on 13 October 2021 through the Metro Manila Local Government Units subject to the continued observance and enforcement of COVID-19 protocols and minimum public health standards.**

This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.

**APPROVED AND ADOPTED this 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 2021 in Makati City, Metro Manila.**


  
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
  
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
  
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
