**MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 21-24**  
**Series of 2021**

**SETTING THE STANDARDIZED AND UNIFIED RESTRICTIONS ON  
THE INTRAZONAL AND INTERZONAL TRAVEL OF PERSONS  
BELOW EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OLD THROUGH THE LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT UNITS OF METRO MANILA**

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) issued its “Guidelines on the Implementation of Alert Levels System for COVID-19 Response in Pilot Areas” dated 13 October 2021, Part I, Section 4 (1) of which provides that:

“SECTION [4] GUIDELINES FOR AREAS UNDER ALERT LEVEL 3. The following protocols shall be observed in areas placed under Alert Level 3, except for portions thereof under granular lockdown:

1. Intrazonal and interzonal travel shall be allowed **subject to reasonable restrictions based on age** and comorbidities, **as may be determined by the LGUs**, which should not be stricter as those prescribed under Alert Level 4 and subject to the oversight, monitoring, and evaluation of their respective RIATF. Provided, that those below eighteen (18) years of age, and those belonging to the vulnerable population, shall be allowed access to obtain essential goods and services, or for work in permitted industries and offices in accordance with existing labor laws, rules, and regulations. Individual outdoor exercises shall also be allowed for all ages regardless of comorbidities or vaccination status.” (Emphasis supplied);

**WHEREAS**, the National Capital Region was placed under Alert Level 3 starting on 16 October 2021 until 31 October 2021 pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 143-A dated 14 October 2021;


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the above Guidelines, all of the Local Chief Executives in Metro Manila have agreed to enact their respective Executive Orders and/or adopt or amend their respective Ordinances for the proper implementation of the standardized and unified restrictions on the intrazonal and interzonal travel of persons below eighteen (18) years old;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council sets the standardized and unified restrictions on the intrazonal and interzonal travel of persons below eighteen (18) years old in accordance with Part I, Section 4 (1) of the IATF “Guidelines on the Implementation of Alert Levels System for COVID-19 Response in Pilot Areas” dated 13 October 2021, through the Local Government Units of Metro Manila, as follows:

**The intrazonal and interzonal travel of persons below eighteen (18) years old shall be allowed provided that these persons shall be accompanied by a parent or an adult guardian at all times.**


This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.




