**MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 21-27**  
**Series of 2021**

**ESTABLISHING THE UNIFIED STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES ON  
THE CONDUCT OF CHRISTMAS BAZAARS, *TIANGGES*, AND POP-  
UP STORES IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION**

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF) issued its “Guidelines on the Implementation of Alert Levels System for COVID-19 Response in Pilot Areas” as of 04 November 2021;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 147 dated 04 November 2021, the National Capital Region (NCR) was placed under Alert Level 2 from 05 November 2021 until 21 November 2021 wherein, pursuant to Part I Section 5 of the above Guidelines, a number of establishments and activities are already allowed to operate or be undertaken subject to venue capacity limitations, vaccination status, and observance of minimum public health standards;

**WHEREAS**, with the coming Christmas season, it is expected that the NCR will have the traditional bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores with the expected influx of holiday shoppers;

**WHEREAS**, these bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores are seasonal in nature and their traders, salespersons, exhibitors, organizers, and other personnel come from different parts of the country thereby making contact tracing highly difficult on the part of the concerned local government units in the event of COVID-19 exposure or infection;

**WHEREAS**, on 19 September 2019, a polio outbreak happened in the Philippines with bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores being identified as significant contributors in its spread;


**WHEREAS**, in order to guard against exposure to and/or infection with the COVID-19 virus similar to the September 2019 polio outbreak, there is a need to require all traders, salespersons, exhibitors, organizers, and other personnel to be fully vaccinated prior to their actual conduct of such Christmas bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council establishes the unified standards and guidelines on the conduct of Christmas bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores in the National Capital Region through the Metro Manila Local Government Units thereby requiring all traders, salespersons, exhibitors, organizers, and other personnel to be **fully vaccinated** prior to their actual conduct of Christmas bazaars, *tiangges*, and pop-up stores.

This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.
