**URGING THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE FOR THE
MANAGEMENT OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES TO
PLACE THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION UNDER COVID-19
ALERT LEVEL 1 STATUS STARTING ON 01 MARCH 2022**

WHEREAS, pursuant to IATF Resolution No. 161-A, Series of 2022, dated 14 February 2022, the National Capital Region (NCR) was placed under COVID-19 Alert Level 2 from 16 February 2022 until 28 February 2022;

WHEREAS, the Department of Health (DOH) Health Care Capacity Utilization Status in the NCR as of 20 February 2022 shows that the Health Care Utilization Rate (HCUR) and COVID-19 Bed Utilization Rate in the Region are both on a downward trend and equally stand at 24.8%;

WHEREAS, the DOH COVID-19 Situationer in the NCR as of 21 February 2022 states that: 1) the Region accounts for 32% of the confirmed cases nationwide; 2) the Distribution of RT-PCR Tests Done and Positivity Rates by LGU shows a Regional Average Positivity Rate of 4.64%; and 3) the Risk Classification and Health Systems Capacity by LGU evidences that out of the seventeen (17) Metro Manila Local Government Units, only one (1) LGU remains at a Moderate Risk Classification while the rest are already at a Low Risk Classification based on the 2-Week Growth Rate and Average Daily Attack Rate;

WHEREAS, the above data manifest a continuing improvement in the COVID-19 situation in the NCR and, further considering the high vaccination rate in the Region's target population, the Metro Manila Council has taken a uniform and united position to urge the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to place the NCR under COVID-19 Alert Level 1 Status starting on 01 March 2022;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executives of the NCR are ready and fully capable of implementing the IATF-prescribed health and safety protocols under COVID-19 Alert Level 1 Status;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council urges the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious

Diseases to place the National Capital Region under COVID-19 Alert Level 1 Status starting on 01 March 2022.

This Resolution shall immediately take effect after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, U. P. Law Center.
