URGING THE MMDA TO REVIVE THE ANTONIO ARNAIZ AVENUE, SEN. GIL PUYAT AVENUE AND DON MARIANO MARCOS AVENUE EXTENSION PROJECTS AND INCLUDE THE SAME IN ITS 2006 PRIORITY PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the Antonio Arnaiz Avenue, Gil Puyat Avenue (Makati City) and Don Mariano Marcos Avenue Extension (Quezon City) Projects are components under the Secondary Road Program of the Metro Manila Urban Transport Integration Project (MMURTRIP) aimed to disperse traffic over the road network and reduce congestion in arterial roads;

WHEREAS, the scope of works of the three (3) aforesaid projects under the Secondary Road Program of the MMURTRIP involve pavement rehabilitation, drainage and sidewalk improvement and measures to safeguard pedestrians, and improve street level interchange among public transport modes;

WHEREAS, due to the limited budget given to the Project during the previous years and the increase in cost from the time the Feasibility Study for the Project was prepared, the MMDA has forwarded to the World Bank its intention to cancel some subcomponents of MMURTRIP to include these three (3) secondary roads projects, hence, not included in the list of current priority projects of MMDA;

WHEREAS, the Metro Manila Council Appropriations Committee, thru its Chairperson, Hon. Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., presented the Committee Resolution entitled *"Urging the MMDA to revive the Antonio Arnaiz Avenue, Sen Gil Puyat Avenue and Don Mariano Marcos Avenue Extension Projects and include the same in its 2006 Priority Projects"* and cited the significance of reviving the aforesaid three (3) projects;

WHEREAS, the Council in session duly assembled, after deliberation, recognized the importance of the three (3) projects as these are all geared to improve the traffic situation in Metro Manila.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Metro Manila Council, hereby urges the MMDA to revive the Antonio Arnaiz Avenue, Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue and Don Mariano Marcos Extension Projects and include the same in its 2006 priority projects.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that in case these projects will not be included in the 2006 Priority Projects of MMDA, the Council hereby urges the MMDA to include the same in its 2007 Priority Projects and to exert extra efforts to secure counterpart funding from the GOP.
