SUSPENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AND THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE RELATIVE TO TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT IN METRO MANILA

WHEREAS, in April 1995, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was entered into by and between the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) and the Philippine National Police (PNP) outlining the duties and responsibilities of both with regard to traffic enforcement in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, the said MOA provided for the detail to MMDA of a minimum of One Thousand (1,000) PNP personnel under the PNP Traffic Management Command and also consolidated the PNP force with the MMDA traffic force, composed of about two thousand MMDA traffic enforcers in one unified command under the Traffic Enforcement Group (TEG);

WHEREAS, in the preceding years, the PNP force in TEG gradually depleted due to retirement, recall, transfer and re-assignment, until such time that there were only about six hundred (600) personnel left in the unit. Another batch of three hundred (300) PNP personnel, assigned to perform traffic functions, were downloaded to the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO) police district offices since January 2006 with only forty six (46) PNP officers remaining in TEG at ~~the~~ present.

WHEREAS, the forty six (46) remaining PNP in TEG is insufficient to effectively and efficiently undertake traffic enforcement along the thoroughfares of the seventeen (17) Local Government Units of Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, through the years, the MMDA continued to strengthen the traffic enforcement in Metro Manila by hiring competent college graduates and providing them continuous training thru the MMDA Traffic Academy;

WHEREAS, majority of MMDA's Traffic Enforcers are equipped with all the knowledge on traffic enforcement and a number of them are already well-trained and experienced in undertaking traffic investigation;

WHEREAS, the Council deems it appropriate to suspend the implementation of the MOA entered into by and between MMDA and PNP relative to traffic enforcement in Metro Manila and give the sole responsibility to MMDA Traffic Enforcers.



RESOLVED FINALLY, that the deputation of the PNP officers previously assigned in the TEG is hereby revoked. Hence, PNPs are no longer allowed by MMDA to undertake traffic enforcement functions in all thoroughfares of Metro Manila.

This Resolution takes effect upon approval.




