**MMDA Resolution No. 08-08
Series of 2008**

EXEMPTING ALL CARGO TRUCKS AND OTHER SIMILAR VEHICLES LOADED WITH AGRICULTURAL FOODSTUFFS FROM MMC ORDINANCE NO. 78-04 AS AMENDED BY MMA ORDINANCE NO. 5, SERIES OF 1994 KNOWN AS THE TRUCK BAN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, MMC Ordinance No. 78-04 as amended by MMA Ordinance No. 5, Series of 1994 known as the TRUCK BAN Ordinance, was enacted to decongest and solve the perennial traffic problem brought about by the growing number of vehicles plying along Metro Manila's thoroughfares;

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance covers cargo trucks and other similar vehicles loaded with agricultural foodstuffs preventing on-time delivery to consumers resulting to inadequate food supply and unabated price increase of these products nationwide.

WHEREAS, there is a need to exempt cargo trucks and other similar vehicles carrying agricultural foodstuffs from the Truck Ban Ordinance to ensure a twenty-four hour delivery of these goods throughout the country;

WHEREAS, the Metro Manila Council, in session duly assembled, after due deliberation, recognized the urgent need to implement measures that will ensure abundant supply of food to consumers nationwide.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved, pursuant to Section 6 of RA 7924, that the Council hereby exempts all cargo trucks and other similar vehicles loaded with agricultural foodstuffs from the Truck Ban Ordinance to ensure continuous and on time delivery of these products, preserve quality and maintain food supply at reasonable cost. Provided, that said trucks shall not pass along the stretch of EDSA except when crossing or using the U-turn slots thereat.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that agricultural foodstuffs in this Resolution shall include but not limited to the following: rice, corn, wheat, flour and perishable foodstuffs such as raw meat, fish, eggs, fresh vegetables and fruits and all other foodstuffs with 24-hour shelf-life.


