DESIGNATING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) TO HAVE FULL CONTROL AND RESPONSIBILITY ON THE CAMANAVA FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS

WHEREAS, the cities of Caloocan, Malabon, Navotas and Valenzuela, otherwise known as CAMANAVA area, are in constant flooding during high tide and rainy season that worsen the living and economic conditions of the constituents thereof;

WHEREAS, the flooding problem in CAMANAVA area is aggravated by the indiscriminate dumping of debris in Navotas, Malabon and Tullahan rivers and other tributaries by the constituents thereof, thus the waterways are clogged by silt of garbage, despite several flood control projects that were implemented in the said area;

WHEREAS, to improve the management of flood control project in CAMANAVA as among the flooded areas in Metro Manila, there is a need to grant the full responsibility of flood control project of CAMANAVA to the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH);

WHEREAS, after due deliberation in session duly assembled, the Metro Manila Council agreed to grant the full responsibility of flood control in CAMANAVA a period of three (3) years to minimize if not totally eradicate the constant flooding in the said area.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved pursuant to Section 6 of RA 7924, the Council hereby designates the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) to have full control and responsibility on the CAMANAVA area flood control project for a period of three (3) years.


