**RESOLUTION AMENDING MMDA REGULATION NO. 96-005, MMDA  
RESOLUTION NO. 03-10, AND MMDA RESOLUTION NO. 16-12**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Republic Act No. 7924, the Metro Manila Council promulgated MMDA Regulation No. 96-005 entitled “Unified Vehicular Volume Reduction Program Regulating the Operation of Certain Motor Vehicles on All Roads in Metropolitan Manila” therein establishing the UVVRP;

**WHEREAS**, under the UVVRP as amended, public and private motor vehicles, with the exception of tricycles and motorcycles, with license plates ending as shown hereunder shall be prohibited from operating in all national, city, and municipal roads of Metro Manila from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. during the corresponding days of the week, thus:

LICENSE PLATE ENDING	PROHIBITED DAYS OF THE WEEK
1 and 2	Mondays
3 and 4	Tuesdays
5 and 6	Wednesdays
7 and 8	Thursdays
9 and 0	Fridays

with window hours, *i. e.*, allowable hours, for private motor vehicles only from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. per MMDA Resolution No. 03-10;

**WHEREAS**, despite the UVVRP, traffic congestion still exists along major thoroughfares in Metro Manila;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Council for Traffic (I-ACT) has strongly recommended to the Metro Manila Council that:

1. The prohibited operating hours under the UVVRP be made effective from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.; and

2. The window hours for private motor vehicles under MMDA Resolution No. 03-10 be removed along the identified major thoroughfares;

**WHEREAS**, the Metro Manila Council finds such recommendations to be warranted under the prevailing traffic conditions;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved, that the Metro Manila Council hereby adopts this Resolution as follows:

1. Public and private motor vehicles, with the exception of tricycles and motorcycles, with license plates ending as shown hereunder shall be prohibited from operating in all national, city, and municipal roads of Metro Manila from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. during the corresponding days of the week, thus:

LICENSE PLATE ENDING	PROHIBITED DAYS OF THE WEEK
1 and 2	Mondays
3 and 4	Tuesdays
5 and 6	Wednesdays
7 and 8	Thursdays
9 and 0	Fridays

2. The window hours for private motor vehicles under MMDA Resolution No. 03-10 are hereby removed in the following major thoroughfares:

as well as in Alabang-Zapote Road in Muntinlupa City and Samson Road and A. Mabini Street in Caloocan City.


3. Henceforth, the prohibition on the use of private motor vehicles in the above-enumerated roads is effective from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. However, crossing the intersections in such roads is allowed. The provisions of MMDA Regulation No. 96-005, MMDA Resolution No. 03-10, and MMDA Resolution No. 16-12, not otherwise affected by this Resolution, shall remain in full force and effect.

This Resolution shall be effective five (5) days after its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and submission of a copy thereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register, UP Law Center.
