**IMPLEMENTING A MODIFIED UNIFORM TRUCK BAN REGULATION IN METRO MANILA**

**WHEREAS**, the Metro Manila Council (MMC) approved the implementation of the uniform truck ban hours in Metro Manila when it enacted MMDA Resolution No. 07-05, Series of 2007;

**WHEREAS**, under said MMDA Resolution 07-05, the uniform truck ban in Metro Manila is being implemented from 6:00 AM to 9:00AM and 5:00PM to 9:00PM everyday except Sundays and Holidays;

**WHEREAS**, under existing rules, particularly MMC Ordinance No. 05, Series of 1994, total truck ban along EDSA is currently being implemented from 6:00 AM to 9:00PM;

**WHEREAS**, the MMC has authorized its Special Traffic Committee to determine and authorize the implementation of a modification of the truck ban regulations in order to respond to pressing needs to alleviate traffic congestion in the major thoroughfares of Metro Manila;

**WHEREAS**, after several consultation meeting with all concerned stakeholders, the Special Traffic Committee of the MMC recommends the immediate implementation of modified uniform truck ban rules;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved, the following modified truck ban rules should be immediately implemented by the MMDA:

1. Cargo trucks and heavy vehicle having a gross capacity weight of more than 4,500 kilograms are covered by this Resolution.
2. The modified uniform truck ban hours shall be from 6:00AM to 10:00AM and from 5:00PM to 10:00 PM every day except Sundays and Holidays.
3. The total truck ban in the whole stretch of EDSA from Magallanes, Makati City to Balintawak, Quezon City shall be implemented the whole day from Monday to Sunday.
4. This Resolution shall be implemented from December 7, 2012 to January 6, 2013.

5. Cargo trucks loaded with perishable and agricultural cargo as defined in MMDA Resolution No. 08-08, Series of 2008 shall to be exempted from this Resolution and shall continue to be covered by MMDA Resolution No. 08-08.
6. The MMDA Chairman is hereby authorized to issue Circulars to implement this Resolution and to coordinate with the concerned local government units, the Bureau of Customs, the Philippine Ports Authority and other government agencies for a more efficient and effective implementation of this Resolution.
7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
